

Beaconsfield-Baie d'Urfé Borough By-Law and Ordinances: Exceptions and Permits

(Replacing Panels 2 and 3 of the "Montreal goes Pesticide-free" Brochure)

Exceptions

Prohibited products may be used in certain exceptional situations, all of which are outlined in the new by-law and Borough ordinances:

- Companies or organizations involved in the production or storage of food products (designated specifically for the Industrial Park in Baie d' Urfé)
- An infestation that may result in a safety hazard.

Permits

- Under the new by-law and Borough ordinances, **no** permits will be issued unless the circumstances qualify as an exception listed above.
- The validity period of a temporary permit is 3 days from the date issued.

Note: All requests for permits will be subject to an inspection by the Borough.



Other

- All organizations, companies, facilities or institutions involved in the production or storage of food who are granted a permit to apply pesticides, must conform to the strict conditions laid out by the City, Borough and Pesticides Management Code regarding the times, distances, signs posted, locations and weather conditions when applying pesticides.
- Furthermore, every operator of a food company or facility must also submit a detailed progress report to the Borough stating the actions and goals made towards reducing their reliance on the use of pesticides.

Use of products that are considered non-toxic is permitted except for the control of vegetation.
